


OUR VISION

2023 ACHIEVEMENTS

We championed clean-up activities at Rumphi Urban, targeting 5 densely populated places such as the district hospital and marketplaces. Our work was featured in major media houses such as Times360 Online and Zodiak Online.


We also championed tree-planting activities targeting disaster-prone areas such as Mzokoto and Rumphi Urban. A total of 11,700 trees were planted in 2023 alone.

We conducted 16 awareness campaigns on climate change targeting youth clubs and secondary schools around Rumphi urban, Mzokoto and Bolero areas. A total of 4,986 youths were reached in 2023 alone.

Taking advantage of the availability of Rumphi community radio and social media platforms, we developed and aired 41 radio programs on climate change. We also shared 73 articles in form of electronic adverts on social media.




Graph below shows the number of young people reached with our interventions using different channels in 2023
